** Salah times are for Piscataway, NJ and vicinity. Please adjust times according to local sources. Zuhr time is calculated as 3 minutes after zawaal. It is not allowed to perform salah (with sajdah) for a 6 minute period before the start time for Zuhr. Asr time is based on Hanafi fiqh. In Shafee/Maliki fiqh, it starts about 1 hour – 1 hour 15 min. earlier.

and do not show slackness in struggle and
if something (bad) befalls you, you should not say:
‘If I had done so and so, such and such thing would
not have happened’, but you should say
‘Allah destined it and did what He wanted’,
for with (the word) ‘if’ starts the work of Satan.”
