\* There is a possibility that the 1st of Ramadan will be on July 20th. Eid ul Fitr (1<sup>st</sup> of Shawwal) is expected to be on August 19th. Please confirm dates for Ramadan with the Masjid via phone or web site above. Salah times are for Piscataway, NJ and vicinity. Please adjust times according to local sources. Note that while Fajr is calculated using the standard juristic method, there are other methods which calculate Fajr (start time of the fast) to be 10-15 min. earlier. Zuhr time is calculated as 3 minutes after zawaal. It is not allowed to perform salah (with sajdah) for a 6 minute period before the start time for Zuhr. Asr time is based on Hanafi fiqh. In Shafee/Maliki fiqh, it starts about 1 hour - 1 hour 15 min. earlier. Salah times are available online at: <http://www.mcmcnj.org>
