Introduction

The Muslim Center of Middlesex County was founded in 1986. Since its inception, and especially after moving into a permanent building in 1997, the center has played a vital role in the development of Islamic community.

The Prayers

The Masjid remains open for all prayers from Fajr through Isha. Friday and Taraweeh prayers are widely attended. During Ramadan besides Taraweeh prayer detailed Qur'anic Tafseer are presented by a renowned Islamic scholar. The Eid congregational prayers are arranged at rental halls to facilitate larger gatherings.

An-Noor Academy

A full-time Islamic School offering a competitive curriculum in all academic subjects as well as Islamic studies, Arabic and Qur'an. Presently, the school is offering 6 classes ranging from Pre-School to 3rd grade and plans are underway to extend to higher grades at a new facility. Due to the effort of our dedicated staff the school has produced excellent results in national standardized tests.

Darul Huda

A full time Tehfiz school preparing boys and girls to memorize the Qur'an with proper Tajweed under direct supervision of qualified male and female teachers. Academic course from 1st to 10th grade are offered so that students can keep up with their school requirements. The school has already produced a few Huffaz who are leading Taraweeh prayer at various Masajids.

Evening School

Students attend classes in Qur'an and Islamic studies. Preparation is underway to start coaching classes in regular subjects as well as SAT preparation.

Saturday and Sunday Schools

Due to increased registration, classes are conducted on 2 days where students are taught Qur'an, Islamic studies, Seerah and other topics. Classes are conducted by qualified teachers dedicated to Islamic values and good teaching practices.

Adult Sessions

Intensive sessions in Qur'anic Tafseer, Seerah and the Arabic language are conducted on a regular basis.

Youth Activities

Educational and sports activities are offered providing a unique opportunity to develop leadership qualities and become active Muslims.

Sisters' Programs

Weekly lectures and classes are held on various aspects of Islam. Many social programs are conducted to help the needy among Muslim and non-Muslim communities.

Seminars and Conferences

These programs are held each month and on special occasions to convey the message to a bigger audience.

Da'wah

Islamic literature is made available for wide distribution. Interfaith meetings are regularly held with local Churches and Synagogues. Open houses and seminars are arranged inviting state political and religious leaders as well as public officials. More over prison visits are conducted on a regular basis.

Publication

A monthly newsletter is published and mailed to the community. Also magazines are published on special occasions to help spread the message of Islam.

Library and Book Service

A full-fledged Islamic Library is established which provides educational and other reference materials. Islamic books and other items are also sold to the community.

Funeral Services

Burial and other Funeral services are made available for families to cope with their personal loss.

Nikah, Matrimonial and Counseling Services

Nikah and matrimonial services are provided for the community. Also counseling to help resolve family and social issues are offered.

Zakat

The committee helps many individual and communities who are in dire financial needs.
