There is a possibility that the 1st of Ramadan will be on March 11th. Eid ul Fitr (1st of Shawwal) is expected to be on April 10th. Please confirm dates for Ramadan with the Masjid via phone or web site above. Salah times are for Piscataway, NJ. Please adjust times according to local sources. Note that while Fajr is calculated using the standard juristic method, there are other methods which calculate Fajr (start time of the fast) to be 10-15 min. earlier. Zuhr time is calculated as 1 minute after zawaal. It is not allowed to perform salah (with sajdah) at zawaal time. Asr time is based on Hanafi fiqh. In Shafee/Maliki fiqh, it starts about 45 min.-1 hour earlier. Maghrib time is calculated as 2 min. after sunset in Piscataway to account for surrounding areas.
